

## MCHS Band Booster Meeting February 4th, 2016

### DRAFT MINUTES

Meeting was called to order by the president at 6:05pm.

The minutes for January were read. Karen motioned to accept the minutes for the January meeting as presented, the motion was seconded and passed.

#### **Treasurer Report:**

Paid the deposit on the airline tickets and we have \$9000 left in the bank. We need to make sure people are keeping up on payments, only a few have come in for this month. The next large deposit is due March 15<sup>th</sup> (\$20,000). We need more fundraiser participation from the kids AND Parents going on the trip. MOTION was made by Lorie to accept the treasurer's report. The motion was seconded & passed.

#### **Communications Report:** Madelyn McGrath-

Sent out 358 Fall appeal letters and got 23 responses back with \$2075. Thank you cards will be sent and the band kids will sign them.

The Flea market will be running the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> weekends of the month, please bring in your sellable items, baked goods, and sign up to help on site when you can.

Will be putting together a list of businesses in town to ask for donations and will pass out the letters to everyone so they can be personally delivered.

We need to start a committee for the Town Party Luau and need to get early advertising started.

#### **Director's Report:** Rod Fiester

The first Thursday concert is tomorrow at Ace Hardware. Parents can pick up their students there at 5:15pm.

The Forum event will be on May 14<sup>th</sup> at San Mateo Community College. The band and Chorus will both be attending and have been paid for with ASB funds. They will be visiting the Santa Cruz Boardwalk afterwards and will be returning about 1am.

The kids have been asked to help sell tickets for the upcoming musical and will receive part of the proceeds for doing so.

Mr. Forsythe is going to auction off the BBQ at the Lions Club Crab feed on Saturday and give the money back to the band. He has asked if some band members could attend in uniform.

April 16<sup>th</sup> the band will perform at the marathon, the Raymond parade, and then a few will go to Mormon Bar where they will be servers at a wedding. They will need at least one adult to supervise the wedding event.

A tentative date for the VIP concert will be April 24<sup>th</sup>.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The flea market needs people to help and things to sell.

We need a few more venues for the Thursday concerts so we can continue with them through May.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Need to pass on information to kids and parents on how to keep instruments clean and hygienic. There should be no sharing of instruments and mouth pieces should be kept separate. We need to set up an instrument cleaning day to help the Genungs with the sanitizing of the instruments before they are distributed next year. We also need to be more conscientious about getting instruments and uniforms back at the end of the year.

Karen would like approval to reimburse Marcella for her purchase of props for Winter Guard.

MOTION was made by Lorie to reimburse Marcella for the purchase of Winter Guard props (approximately \$100). The motion was seconded & passed.

The contracts for the Storytelling Festival have been sent in. March 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> we will be selling snacks, drinks & preselling tickets for lunch on Saturday. They also requested 30 individual snacks for the storytellers.

Skip said there are still spots available for talent at the marathon if anyone knows of any local bands. He will check with Sierra Arts Council to see if they will donate art again.
